

THE ANNE HONNER DRESSAGE SCHOLARSHIP

About the Scholarship

The Anne Honner Dressage Scholarship is a non-profit organisation established in memory of Anne Honner - an accomplished Australian dressage rider who devoted much of her life to the pursuit of excellence in Australian dressage. Its mission is to promote good basic dressage training in Australian bred horses, and to assist in their and their rider's further education.

Each year the Scholarship aims to sponsor an amateur Australian rider, on an Australian bred horse, which has been trained by the rider to medium level. Each year a grant will be awarded to the successful applicant based on the criteria set out in the application form.

About the Award

Applicants must be Australian riders on an Australian bred horse, trained by the rider to medium dressage level. A panel of five judges will assess the applications on the following:

1. Their performance in official Australian dressage competitions in the year preceding the date of calling for applications. Standard FEI guidelines (the Grade Point System) will be applied in calculating points.
2. Their completed application form including:
 - Their personal training program
 - How they intend to use the funds
 - How they currently are, and intend to, contribute to the sport of dressage in Australia
4. Nomination of two (2) referees.
